# TOOLS FOR SUPPORTING ENGAGING DIGITAL EVENTS.





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This handy list of tools will help you explore just **some** of the digital options out there for you to use in your engagements as a consultant. Some are free and some require a subscription but all of them provide lots of support and videos on how they can be used.

When planning to use any platform or tool you should think about which tools will elevate your digital delivery yet keep it simple for the participants in your workshop or session. Make sure you also take a look at the guidance on **preparing for delivering to an NSO** and **top tips for great digital sessions**.

Always ask your Regional Support Centre what tools they may have access to if they are subscription based as you may be able to access the use of those too.

# Interactive Feedback and games tools

## **Kahoot**

KAHOOT! is a game-based learning platform that makes it easy to create, share and play learning games or trivia quizzes in minutes. Unleash the fun in classrooms, offices and living rooms!

## **Keamk**

KEAMK is a Random Team Generator. It is a service to create random groups from a list of participants. Keamk also offers the possibility of generating balanced teams using different criteria such as gender or skill level of participants.

## **Quizalize**

QUIZALIZE is an online platform for classroom polling and assessing that can be accessed by computer, tablet, or mobile phone. Teachers can create quizzes to test students' knowledge in the classroom, then see the results propagated in the Teacher Dashboard through data reports.

IDEAFLIP is an innovative, cloud-based mind mapping software designed to help change agents, leaders, facilitators, and innovators collaborate in real-time with colleagues to generate & manage ideas, brainstorm creatively, and solve problems.

### Noteapp

**NOTEAPP** (formerly known as CorkboardMe) is a virtual corkboard that allows users to create sticky notes filled with different types of information and to collaborate with others. Click anywhere on the screen to drop a sticky note, then choose a color and add files or write text.
